Exclude participants, volunteers, parents/carers and participants who are unwell.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Orange Thunder Touch Football will exclude participants (including players, coaches, managers, referees, volunteers, parents/carers and other spectators) who are unwell during training and play. • Orange Thunder Touch Football will promote 'do not attend if unwell' via the Orange Thunder Touch Football website, club social media platforms and other methods of communication to all members. • Orange Thunder Touch Football will set up signage at Waratahs Sports Ground. • Orange Thunder Touch Football will provide a link to COVID-19 relevant information via the Orange Thunder Touch Football website.
Provide staff and volunteers with information and training on COVID-19, including when to get tested, physical distancing and cleaning, and how to manage a sick visitor.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Orange Thunder Touch Football will provide all members with COVID-19 safety protocols and checklists including the need (where applicable) for testing, contact tracing, social/physical distancing, cleaning and hygiene, as well as managing

	<p>sick visitors, or participants (of all types) who become sick/ill during training or play.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Volunteer staff will complete Covid Safe Certificate. • Orange Thunder Touch Football will promote social distancing requirements via the Orange Thunder Touch Football website, club social media platforms, other methods of communication to all members and with signage at Waratahs Sports Ground. • Orange Thunder Touch Football will provide alcohol-based hand wash for hand washing and bacterial wipes to clean balls. • Orange Thunder Touch Football will provide a hand sanitation station at the Touch Clubhouse area.
<p>Make club officials aware of expectations if they are sick or required to self-isolate.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where applicable, Orange Thunder Touch Football will advise club officials of their requirements to self-isolate via email and our expectations and requirements if unwell.
<p>Display conditions of entry (website, social media, venue entry).</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Orange Thunder Touch Football will display conditions of entry (including the requirement to comply with health orders to attend, the need for continued physical distancing, the need to comply with directions from officials and volunteers, facility and crowd limitation etc.) on the Orange Thunder Touch Football website, club social media platforms and other methods of communication to all members. • Orange Thunder Touch Football will display the conditions of entry at the Touch Clubhouse area.
<p>If hiring the facility, consult with the owners/operators to address these requirements to understand what measures may already be in place.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Orange Thunder Touch Football does not sub let or hire out its facilities. Should external parties wish to use any facilities at Waratahs Sports Ground they are to liaise directly with Waratahs Sports Club.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● There will be no access to the Touch Clubhouse unless approval is granted by the Orange Thunder Touch Football Executive.
<p>Ensure processes are in place to exclude participants (including spectators and officials) if they have attended any identified hot spots as per NSW Health website.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football recommends that if you have attended any identified hot spots as per NSW Health website that you do not attend training or competition and you seek medical clearance before returning.
<p>Take all reasonable steps to minimise the number of spectators attending community sport events.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football recommends that spectator attendance to training or play is in line with all current public health orders or other advice from NSW Government. ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will provide communication to our members on spectator attendance to training or play via the Orange Thunder Touch Football website, club social media platforms and other methods of communication. ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will make PA announcements reminding people to ensure spectator attendance remains in line with current public health orders.

Physical distancing	
<p>Ensure the number of people in a facility does not exceed one person per 4 square metres of space (excluding club officials) to a maximum of 500 people.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will promote social distancing requirements with ground signage, via the Orange Thunder Touch Football website, club social media platforms and other methods of communication all members. ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will limit numbers where practical using the overarching limitation of one person per 4 square metres for all their facilities including but not limited to fields, spectator areas, dressing rooms, canteens, BBQ areas and bar facilities.
<p>Minimise co-mingling of participants from different games and time slots where possible.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will minimise co-mingling of participants where practical. ● Where required, Orange Thunder Touch Football will amended draws for our competitions to allow for greater time gap between games played to allow participants to vacate their field and the next time slot games to commence. ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will promote 'Get in, Play, Leave' via the Orange Thunder Touch Football website, club social media platforms and other methods of communication to all members.
<p>Ensure any spectators comply with 1.5 metres physical distance where practical, such as through staggered seating. People who live in the same household are not required to distance. Have strategies in place to prevent spectators from different games and timeslots co-mingling.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will minimise co-mingling of participants where practical. ● Where required, Orange Thunder Touch Football will amended draws for our competitions to allow for greater time gap between games played to allow participants to vacate their field and the next time slot games to commence. ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will promote 'Get in, Play, Leave' via the Orange Thunder Touch Football website, club social media platforms and other methods of communication to all members. ● Players, spectators and officials are encouraged to have the Covid Safe app downloaded.

<p>Have strategies in place to manage gatherings that may occur immediately outside the premises, such as with drop off and pick up zones or staggered start/finish times.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football have and will continue to require their participants including spectators to ensure they form no gatherings in breach of existing public health orders outside the Club facilities. All training and game times have been rescheduled to ensure groups do not form or commingle. ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will promote 'Get in, Play, Leave' via the Orange Thunder Touch Football website, club social media platforms and other methods of communication to members.
<p>Reduce crowding wherever possible and promote physical distancing with markers on the floor where people stand or are asked to queue.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will reduce crowding and promote the physical distancing within their facilities via measurement of space, and a combination of floor markings and signage at entrances advising of maximum people in the applicable area and at the Touch Clubhouse area. ● Where required, Orange Thunder Touch Football will amended draws for our competitions to allow for greater time gap between games played to allow participants to vacate their field and the next time slot games to commence. ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will promote 'Get in, Play, Leave' via the Orange Thunder Touch Football website, club social media platforms and other methods of communication to all members
<p>Ensure communal facilities such as showers, change rooms and lockers have strategies in place to reduce crowding and promote physical distancing.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will assess the safe capacity of their communal facilities via measurement of those spaces, followed by a combination of floor markings and signage at entrances advising maximum people in the applicable area. ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will provide signage indicating reduced toilet usage capacity - one person at a time in bathroom facilities
<p>Where practical, stagger the use of communal facilities. Strongly encourage participants to shower/change at home where possible.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● See above. Orange Thunder Touch Football will be encouraged to not make use of communal change and shower rooms for Junior (18 and under

Hygiene and cleaning

Clean frequently used indoor hard surface areas at least daily; first with detergent and water, and then disinfect. Clean frequently touched areas and surfaces, including in communal facilities, several times per day.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football uses a predominantly outdoor venue. However, all surfaces which are in frequent use during training, play or administration such as the Touch Clubhouse area will be cleaned and disinfected regularly.
Clean areas used for high intensity sports with detergent and disinfectant after each use.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will where practical not use areas for high intensity activity other than sporting fields which do not require cleaning. If any indoor areas are used such as the Club House, then they will be thoroughly cleaned after each use.
Reduce sharing of equipment where practical and ensure these are cleaned with detergent and disinfectant between use.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● There will be no shared use of any uniform items such as playing tops, bibs, referee vests, etc. ● Referees are to wear own shirts and use their own whistles ● Players are not to share and/or swap shirts and water bottles. ● Each player must have their own shirt and wear for the entire game and their own water bottle ● Disinfected ball to be provided by the referee at the beginning of each game. ● Referee is to return the ball after each game to the Touch Clubhouse area for cleaning before further use.
Ensure there is accessible detergent/disinfectant and gloves for visitors to use, should they wish.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will ensure there is accessible detergent/disinfectant available for visitor/spectator should they wish. Orange Thunder Touch Football will also provide masks and gloves which will be available at the Touch Clubhouse area.

Record keeping	
<p>Keep a record of name and contact details for all staff, volunteers, participants, spectators and contractors attending community sports activities for a period of at least 28 days. Ensure records are used only for the purposes of tracing COVID-19 infections and are stored confidentially and securely.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will keep a record of the name of registered participants (players, coaches, team officials, match officials). Participant sign-on sheet to be taken to / returned from each game by referee. Referee to complete. ● All records will be stored by Orange Thunder Touch Football for a period of at least 28 days. ● Spectator attendance will be recorded where practical.
<p>Make your staff and volunteers aware of the COVIDSafe app and its benefits to support contact tracing if required.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will remind all their participants and members to download the COVIDSafe App to support contact tracing if required via the Orange Thunder Touch Football website, club social media platforms and other methods of communication to all members.
<p>Cooperate with NSW Health if contacted in relation to a positive case of COVID-19 at your workplace, and notify SafeWork NSW on 13 10 50.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Orange Thunder Touch Football will remind all their participants and staff to contact NSW Health and Safe Work NSW (as applicable) in the event of a positive case at their venue or facilities.
