



2024/25 Orange Touch Football Volunteer Incentive Scheme

To encourage greater support and assistance with the delivery of the various programs that Orange Touch Football Association has to offer a Volunteer Incentive Scheme will be trialled for the 2024/25 season. There are numerous tasks associated with running the Club and unfortunately there are too few volunteers to cover all that needs to be done.

Presently the current Committee simply cannot keep running local comp nights, carnivals/gala day's and the canteen successfully.

The Volunteer Incentive Scheme provides a financial incentive to our members to become more involved with the club and the array of activities necessary to make the club run smoothly. The Club hopes this will also share the load among all the members of the club rather than all the duties being undertaken by the same volunteers. By committing to regular voluntary roles, members accumulate points, which over a duration of time may be used as payment upon:

- Local competition registration,
- OTA Representative Player Levies,
- Representative Player Uniform,
- Off-Field OTA Merchandise.

Volunteer tasks & roles

Opting to volunteer will contribute hugely to manage and maintain the club whilst developing a culture of participation and teamwork! The Club has a vast array of voluntary role's and this scheme is designed to recognise and reward those who can & do volunteer their time.

Committee Position (no honorarium)	100
Local Competition Field Set Up	10
Local Competition Shed Duty	15
Local Competition Ground's Supervisor	15
Local Competition Buddy Referee	10
Canteen Helper	10
Carnival/Gala Day Support	20
General Meeting Attendance (not for Committee position's)	5
Working Bee	10



Roles can be committed to upon a fortnightly roster basis or for the duration of the season. To achieve full credit points volunteers must remain for the entire shift.

Voluntary time will be recorded upon Individual Task Sheet's (within the Volunteer Incentive Scheme Booklet, located in the OTA Shed), and must be signed off by a OTA Committee Member as witness. Once sufficient credit points have been accumulated, application's for payment of credit's can be made in consultation with the Club's Treasurer. Credit's can only be achieved within the current playing season, they cannot be carried over.

OTA Committee members will provide volunteers with the necessary training that some roles will require to be successfully fulfilled.
